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All required rehabilitation courses must be completed with a C or better before you begin your Internship unless special arrangements have been made with the coordinator of the Rehabilitation Services program. A 2.5/4.0 grade point average is required in the major.

In addition to the above required hours, students must also complete 39 hours of University Core Curriculum Courses and 33 hours of electives. A list of suggested electives may be found in the Undergraduate catalog under Rehabilitation Services.

It is recommended that you take electives that correspond to your career interests. For example, if you are interested in working with the aging population, you may want to take REHB 446, REHB 447, PH 440, or PSYC 304 as your electives. If you are interested in working in the area of substance abuse, then you may want to take REHB 471, PSYC 222 or PH 407 as possible electives. If you are interested in the area of corrections, you may want to take REHB 445c, CCJ 201, CCJ 203, or CCJ 384 as electives.
