

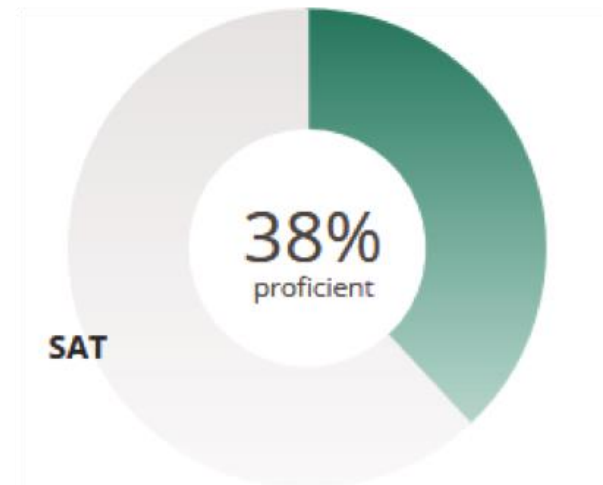

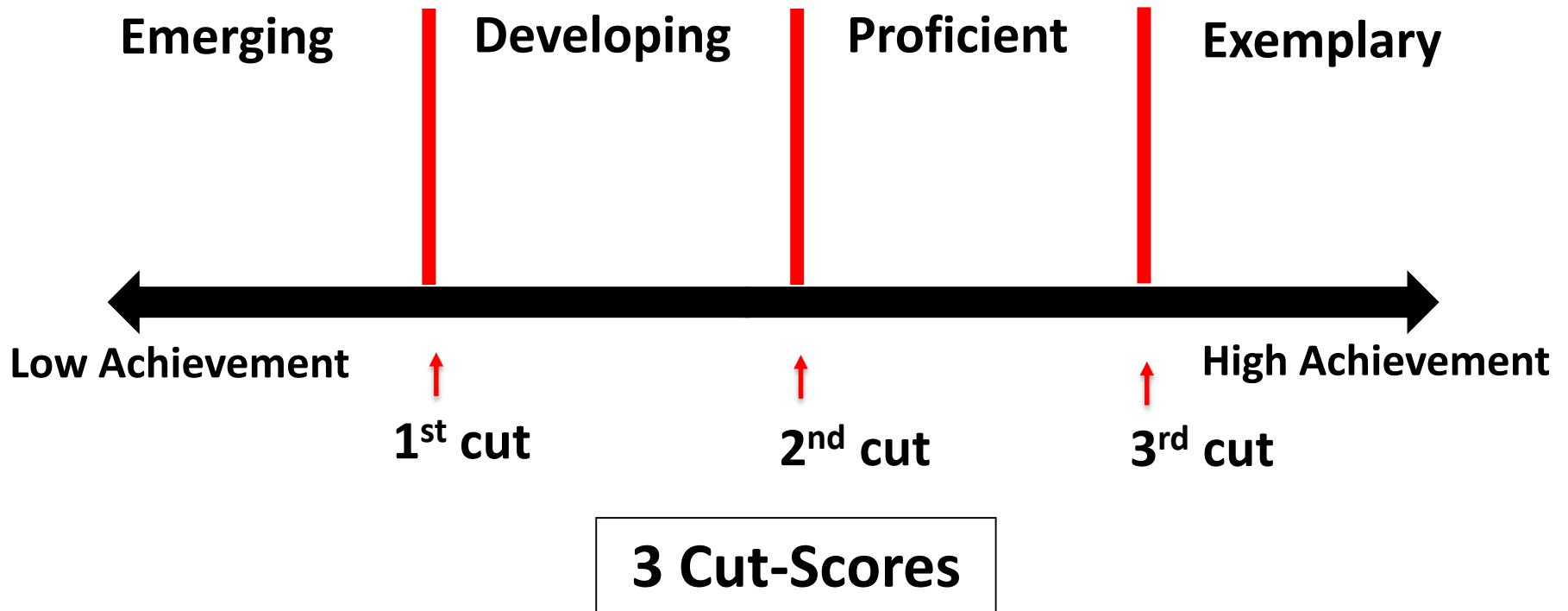

## Modified Angoff Procedure

### Panelists

1. review the item.
2. review the Performance Level Descriptor for the Proficient level:  
*Work at this level meets the standard. It is acceptable work that demonstrates application of essential knowledge and skills. Minor errors or omissions do not detract from the overall quality.*
3. visualize a student who just meets the minimum definition of the Proficient level.
4. indicate the percent of “just meets” students that would answer the item correctly.
