Training and development managers plan, direct, and coordinate programs to enhance the knowledge and skills of an organization's employees.

Work Environment

Training and development managers work in nearly every industry. They typically work in offices and spend much of their time working with people.

Most candidates need a combination of education and related work experience to become a training and development manager.

Pay

The median annual wage for training and development managers was \$105,830 in May 2016.

Job Outlook

Employment of training and development managers is projected to grow 10 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than average for all occupations. Job prospects should be favorable due to the constant need for workplace training and education.
